THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- Registration is inside from 11 am to 12:30 pm the Plunge starts at 1:00
- Registration fee is \$50 (or more) all monies collected must be turned in at the time of registration. All checks must be made out to: **Ogdensburg Chamber**
- Wear your costume/plunging suit under your clothes
- Make sure your plunge day clothes are loose fitting easy on/easy off
- We will have the awards and presentations BEFORE we start the plunge
- The Ogdensburg Volunteer Rescue Squad will be there the whole time they will man the harness and get you safely in and out of the "Plunge Zone"
- We will have a hot showers available inside for all of the plungers
- We will have hot cocoa and coffee for your enjoyment after the plunge to help you get warmed back up

THINGS TO BRING:

- Easy on/easy off shoes no laces think crocs
- A plastic bag for your wet clothes
- Maybe river shoes for wearing to and from the "Plunge Zone"
- A backpack for all your essentials
- Two medium size towels one to dry off with one to stand on!
- Clean, dry undergarments to wear after Plunging
- A disposable, waterproof camera or GoPro to carry into the "Plunge Zone"
